If you meet the qualifications of a Conditionally Exempt Small Quantity Generator (CESQG), as outlined in the Colorado Hazardous Waste Regulations, and are looking for a disposal option for your hazardous waste, we are also able to take business hazardous waste, for a fee (based on waste type). What we take...

paint . stains . motor oil
antifreeze . fuel filters . brake
fluid . flammables . pesticides
batteries (all types) . fertilizer
fluorescent bulbs . corrosives
poisons . cell phones . small
propane tanks . household
cleaners . and more

A Few Guidelines...

- Each container must be five gallons or smaller.
- Unusually large quantities of waste (more than a typical household) will be subject to disposal fees.
- Call ahead if you are bringing in more than 200 lbs. in one load.
- Do not mix different types of hazardous waste.
