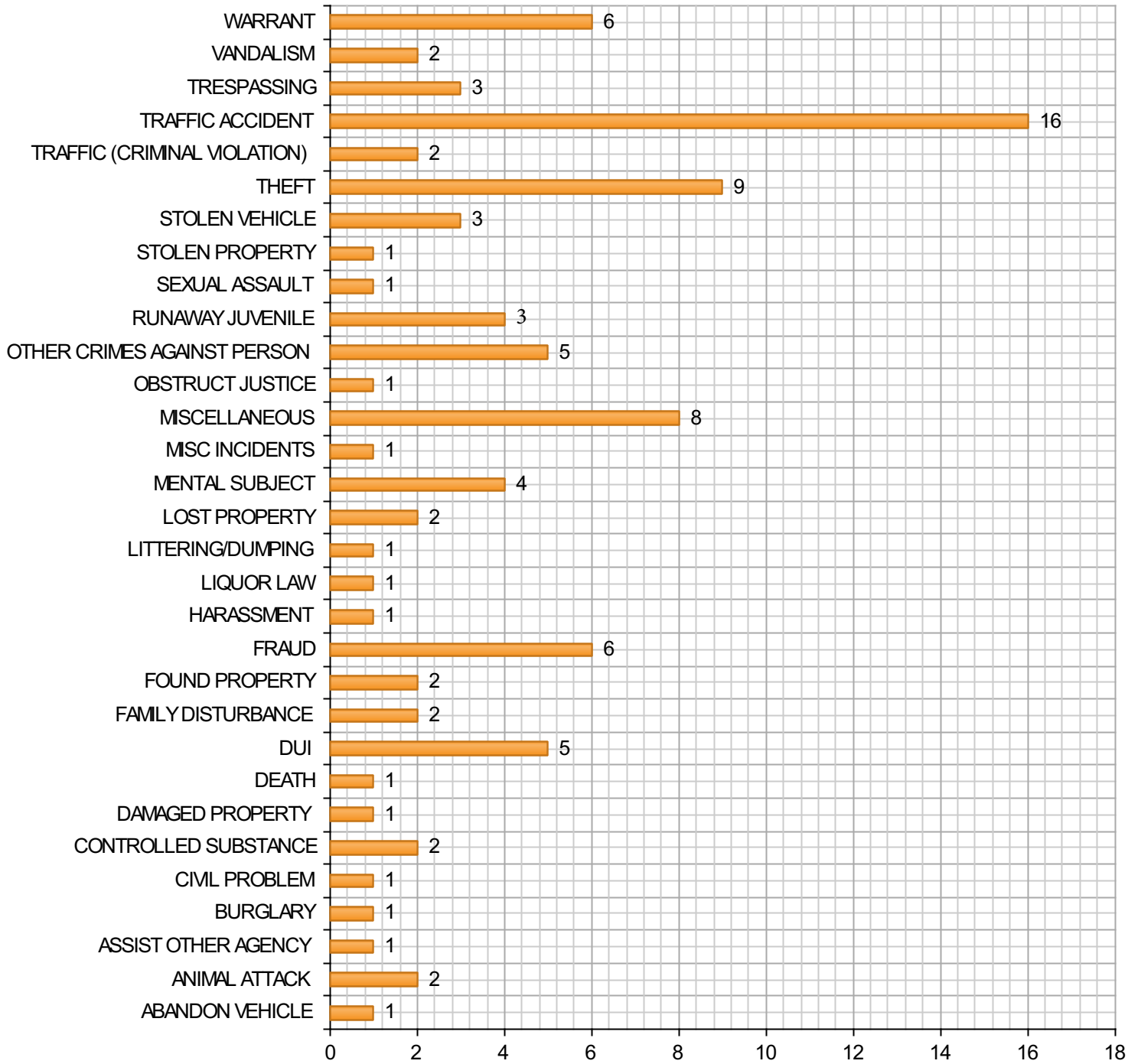

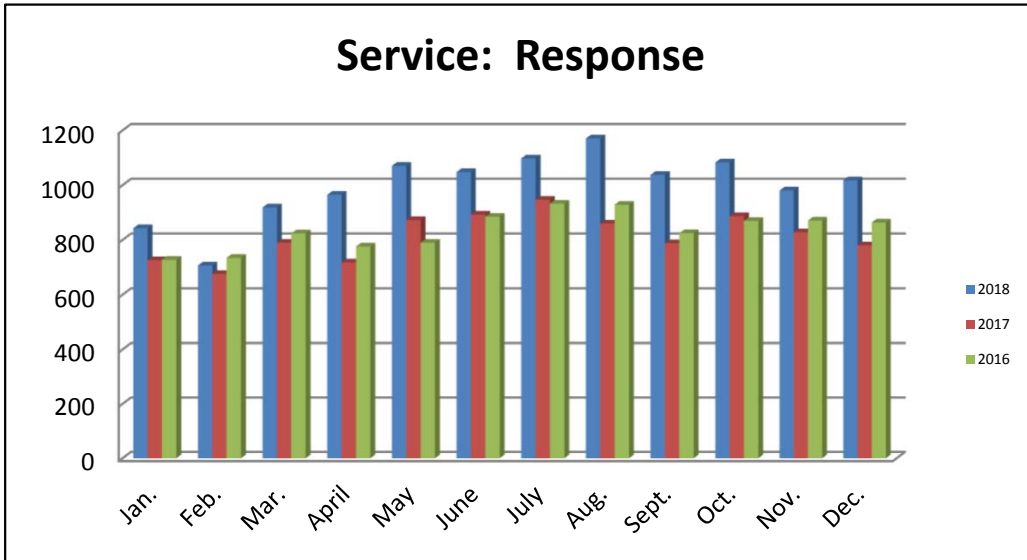

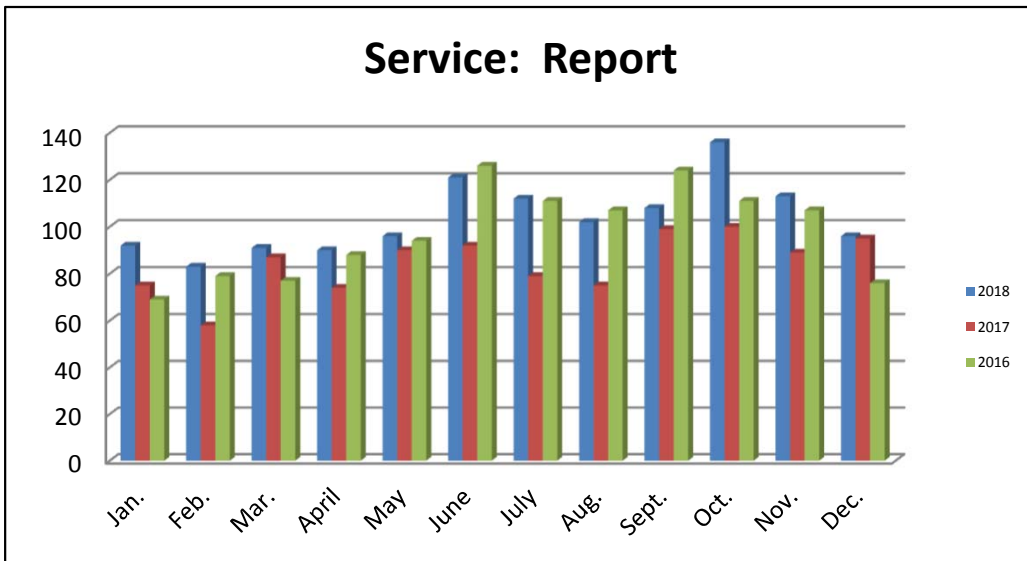

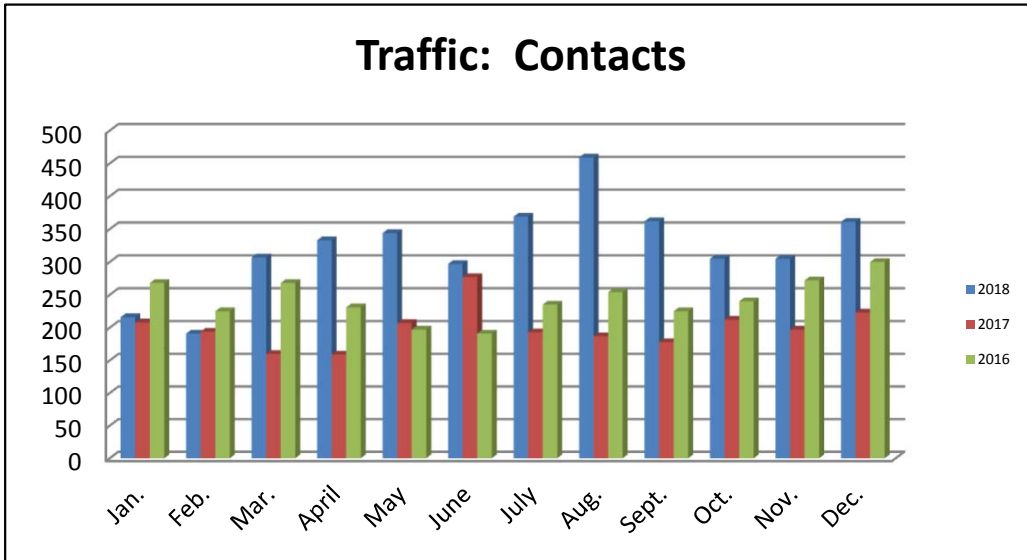

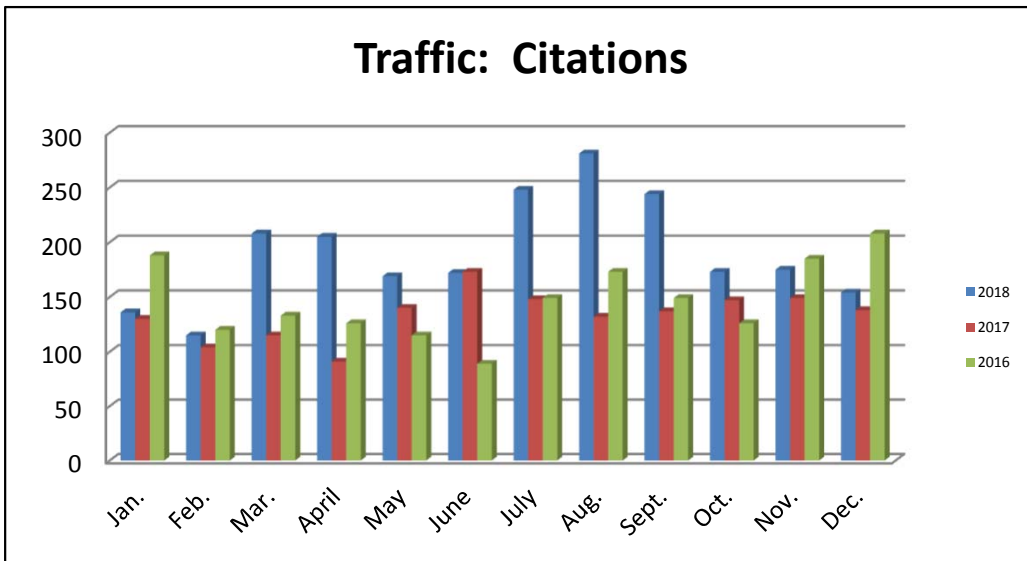

- I have been coaching football at Frederick High School. I spend between 15-18 hours a week staying connected with students while doing this.
- I have attended regular monthly training through the Police Department

Coal Ridge Middle School

- I am not mentoring a 7th grade student. He has a study hall with me daily. We are working on grades and behavior. I was able to get parents to take the student to the doctor for possible ADHD medicine. Student started his medicine on 12/17 and is doing much better. I will continue to mentor him for the rest of the school year.
- I am mentoring an 8th grade student with grades and behavior. He also has a study hall and is doing better.
- Arrested a student for possession of alcohol and tobacco
- Vaping has become a serious issue at the middle school and high school. We had been suspending and requiring lthrive for these violations, but with the amount of students reportedly vaping at school it has been decided to write summons for any vaping violations in the future. Working with Officer Wittler we are working to change our town ordinance to reflect the actual Vapes and not just the nicotine.

Prairie Ridge and Centennial Elementary

- Counsel students that are having behavior issues in the school.
- I meet with students on behalf of the administration to help with behavior and defiance issues.
- Play on the playground with the students to build rapport. Conducted and participated in a reunification drill with Centennial Elementary.
- I placed a 7 year old on a mental health hold at Prairie Ridge Elementary. Student was threatening to stab himself. Student was seen at Children's hospital in Aurora and released.

Imagine Charter School
