In accordance with U.S. Department of Transportation Law 49 CFR §192.707, Kerr-McGee Gathering LLC ("KMGG"), over the next 60 days, will be conducting line locates, as well as updating and installing permanent markers on your property in order to locate (identify) our pipelines. As part of KMGG's marking process, we may be using an all-terrain vehicle on parcels of significant acreage to carry equipment for this project to minimize our footprint on your surface. If you have a question or concern about the locate process, our marking process, or a concern with KMGG using an all-terrain vehicle on your property, please do not hesitate to contact me at the number mentioned below.

Should you have a tenant or farm manager handling the property, please provide them with the appropriate notice. We also need to know of any private utilities, irrigation lines or other infrastructure that exists on your property.

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## FAQ'S

**1. *Will you be using an ATV vehicle on my property?***

ATV vehicles will only typically be utilized on properties of significant acreage.

**2. *What is the purpose of your operations?***

In accordance with Department of Transportation Law 49 CFR §192.707, we are required to perform inspections by amending old or destroyed pipeline markers. If no replacement is necessary, we will simply update our GPS system to verify its proper location.

**3. *I have irrigation lines on my land, how can I be sure your crews will not damage my irrigation lines?***

Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions or concerns about the location of certain irrigation lines or other facilities. We would be glad to meet with you prior to our arrival to ensure that any irrigation lines or underground utilities are not disturbed. In order to schedule an onsite prior to our operations, please call me at (970) 515-1537.

**4. *Will you be inserting pin flags into the ground?***

Pin flags will be temporarily inserted into the ground; however, our crews will remove them as soon work is completed on your property.

**5. *I have livestock and/or pets - will they be affected by your operations?***

Please feel free to contact us if you have any questions or concerns about us operating around your livestock and/or pets. We would be glad to meet with you prior to our arrival to ensure that any livestock and/or pets are not disturbed. In order to schedule an onsite prior to our operations, please call me at (970) 515-1537.

**6. *How deep are the marker posts? What process do you use in order to insert them in the ground?***

Our typical pipeline marker is approximately 4 inches wide and 5 feet tall. They will be inserted approximately eighteen inches into the ground and the method used to install these markers will be done manually by our crews.

**7. *How long will this process take?***

The length of time needed to complete the process on your property is dependent upon the size of the parcel. If for example, you live in a subdivision, it should take less than an hour. However, if you live on a twenty acre tract, it could take a few hours.
