NOTICE OF PLANNED CONSTRUCTION ACTIVITY

Wooster Avenue Water Line and Street Replacement Projects

In 2013, the Town of Firestone voters approved a 1% sales tax initiative that would fund street and park operations and maintenance costs, including funding the replacement of the more than 40-year-old streets in Old Town. As part of this street replacement project, the Town will replace the water lines in Old Town first followed by the street replacement in order to avoid large street patches on the newly paved streets.

The 2019 improvements will be along Wooster Avenue and are set to begin June 2019. The new water line will be built parallel to the existing line so that we can minimize disruption of water service. The existing service lines will be crossed over to connect to the new system after the lines have been installed and tested. New curb stops will also be installed at each residence. Prior to your water being turned off to make the improvements, you will be contacted by our contractor. Service down time should last only a couple of hours.

The roadway improvements will be completed upon the successful completion of the new water line. The improvements include regrading the roadway to alleviate some drainage issues, and removing and replacing all existing asphalt. Portions of the existing sidewalk, curb and gutter on both sides of the roadway will also be removed and replaced.

Due to the nature of the work it will be necessary to close portions of blocks during the day. Detours will be provided to route traffic around the active work areas as efficiently as possible. Residents immediately adjacent to the active work areas will have limited vehicular access while the work is taking place to allow the work to progress more quickly and help ensure your safety. Again, you will be notified by the contractor ahead of time to plan accordingly. We expect these restrictions to be of fairly short duration, typically less than 5 days, however, weather and unknown underground obstructions could impede our progress. Throughout the duration of the project, access to your home by emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times. If you have any medical or mobility issues that make restricted access to your home onerous please contact us and we will make special arrangements. Similarly, if you have an event planned at your home, please let us know and we will make every effort to accommodate your access.

Work will take place Monday through Friday between the hours of 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. and on weekends between the hours of 9 a.m. and 5 p.m. Work will begin at the intersection of First Street and Wooster Avenue and progress towards Fourth Street.
