Crestone Peak Resources will soon begin the task of plugging and abandoning a single well on the nearby Wandell location called the Wandell 1. This site is south of County Road 24 and west of County Road 15.

In the next week, a truck mounted service rig will move in and rig up on the single well pad. The crew will pull tubing out of the well, set a permanent plug in the wellbore, and cement the well per Colorado Oil & Gas Conservation Commission (COGCC) regulations. Once set, the cement casing will be cut-off below surface and a metal plate will be welded into place. All production facility equipment and the flowlines connected to this site will be removed as well.

Equipment expected on location during this time includes a truck mounted service rig, various pieces of heavy equipment, temporary water tanks, trucks and worker pickup trucks. All access to this site is limited to the designated access route.

This activity is expected to take about five days to complete. There are other wells producing to this location so some surface equipment will remain on this site.
