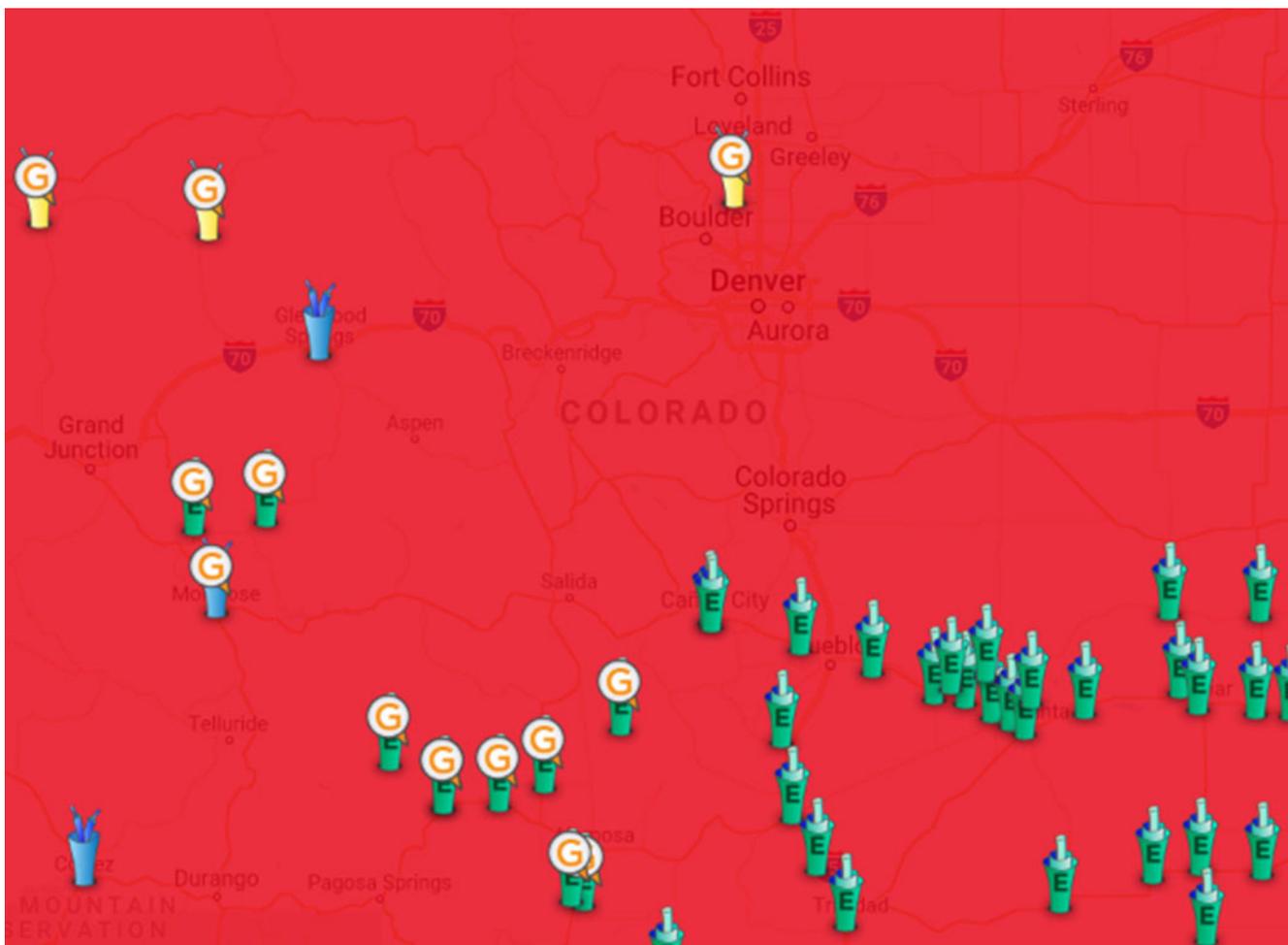
National

- ❑ Half of Americans now have access to broadband at speeds of 500 Mbps or above.
- ❑ But less than half of Americans (48.5%) have wired broadband available at \$60 or less per month.
- ❑ 6 of 10 fastest ISPs in US = public or public/private*.

Colorado

- ❑ 160 Colorado entities have overturned SB-152
- ❑ 7 public networks/cooperatives currently in operation

- Board of Trustees

Recommendation

- Broadband Assessment & Feasibility Study
 - ✓ Review of current assets and providers
 - ✓ Create map of the Town's broadband environment
 - ✓ Identify opportunities & partnerships
 - ✓ Structured evaluation of business/funding models
 - ✓ Consistent, transparent and inclusive communications

Study Timeline

- ❑ Meet w/ stakeholders to inform RFP development
- ❑ Review existing conditions (studies, agreements...),
- ❑ Issue RFP
- ❑ Solicit proposals
- ❑ Review proposals/determine preferred vendor
- ❑ Assessment, study and survey conducted
- ❑ Consistent, transparent and inclusive communications
- ❑ Final report to Board of Trustees
