Accepted: As a Municipal Solid Waste Landfill (MSW), the Front Range Landfill is authorized to only accept certain types of materials and all incoming loads are subject to random inspection. If you have a question about any type of waste, please contact us in advance of bringing the material to landfill. * For safety and environmental reasons, it is critical to cover or tarp and secure all loads in such a manner that no debris can fly out or become airborne in anyway. Per state regulations, all uncovered or unsecured loads will be charged double.
