



FOOD & FLICK FRIDAYS DRIVE-IN REGULATIONS AND TIPS

As this is a new adventure for us as it is for you, please see this list of rules and tips to make this new experience fun and safe for everyone.

ARRIVAL AND PARKING

- Entrance into the parking area will be located on Falcon St. only. Please know that as we move people into the parking area, there will likely be a little back up as we give attendees their parking information. We encourage you to enter the complex from Frontier St. to alleviate any backups on Firestone Blvd.
- Please use your parking lights (low beams) for navigating the parking if it's dark when you're parking. Please only leave your parking spot/parking area before the movie concludes if there is an emergency.
- Please *DO NOT* change parking spot once you've parked. This can be a potential safety hazard, especially when the film begins.
- Speed limit strict 10 MPH. A reminder that children, adults and people with mobility issues will be on foot in the parking area.
- Please do *not* drive through the parking area to get to a spot. Use the roadways that will be clearly marked.
- We do not allow space saving. Do not leave chairs, tables or 'space savers' in the spot next to you.
- Two cars will fit in between each set of flagged cones. Park close enough to the cone that another vehicle will fit in between.
- Please make sure to keep your headlights OFF for the duration of the film. Not only will this help keep your battery powered up, but will also keep the picture on the screen in front of you as crisp as possible for everyone to view.

Our staff assigns parking by vehicle height

- As cars arrive, they would be handed a color coded sticker that is to be placed on the left side of their windshield. There will be 3 colors: Green, Yellow, Blue
 - Green: Small cars, sedans and small SUVs
 - Yellow: Small trucks and midsize SUVs
 - Blue: Vans, large SUVs, large trucks
 - Vehicles will be parked 'small to tall'
 - Vehicles will know where to park as cones will have flags designating your parking zone per your color coded sticker.
- When vehicles receive their color coded windshield sticker, they will also receive a plastic Firestone bag. That bag will have an information sheet, and various other bits of information. We encourage you to use that bag to collect any trash you might accumulate while at the Drive-In. Trash cans will be available at all parking area exits.
- We recommend removing your roof racks and any obstructions from your vehicle. These will require us to park you further back based on your vehicle's total height.
- Hatches are to be tied down so that they are level with the roof line of your vehicle. Hatches that are fully opened will be asked to be closed.

EXITING THE EVENT

- There will be 2 exits available when you are leaving the parking area.
 - Falcon Exit: You may turn left or right onto Falcon Street towards Firestone Blvd. or Frontier St. Please follow direction of Traffic Control Officers at both of those intersections.
 - Firestone Blvd. Exit: You may only turn right onto Firestone Blvd. from this exit.

FOOD

- As always, we will have our FABULOUS food trucks available for your dining delight. Please visit our website at www.firestoneco.gov/foodandflickfridays to see each individual food trucks online ordering options and social distancing regulations. Please note there will be no window ordering from any of our available food trucks.
- **REMINDER:** Alcoholic beverages are **NOT** allowed in Town parks or on Town property. **Do not bring alcohol to the Drive-In.**

TUNING IN & VIEWING

- An FM radio station will be provided to you as you enter the parking area. Dial in through your car stereo or bring a boom box from home. You will not be able to use a radio app as we are not streaming the film over the internet.
 - The station information will be on the FAQ sheet you receive when you arrive.
- We encourage you to remain in your vehicle for the duration of the film. If you sit in a chair outside of your vehicle, only sit at the nose or tail of your vehicle and no more than 6 inches from your vehicle. Please know this stipulation is for your safety as it will be dark and some vehicles will be in motion and unable to see you easily. Remember, safety first.

PET POLICY

- No pets will be allowed at this time, discouraging the need to be outside of your vehicle unnecessarily and avoiding noise issues.

DRIVE-IN FAQs

HOW IS IT DECIDED ON WHERE I CAN PARK?

We park vehicles according to height: from screen to rear of the parking area, we park cars smallest to tallest. We park vehicles in this fashion to ensure that everyone can see our giant screen. Event staff will provide you with a color-coded parking sticker that you're to place on the inside-left side of your windshield. You must park in your designated parking zone. You will know you're in the right zone because the cone you park next to will have a colored flag that matches your color-coded parking sticker. Our parking attendants & staff may modify policies under varying conditions.

WHAT IF MY CAR BATTERY DIES?

In the event your battery does not hold out, please ask for help at the town Tent/Event van. We will have a jump box available. Please note it is a courtesy service we offer and we are not able to jump vehicles until the film concludes. Should you require a tow truck, please notify staff before calling the tow truck company. We do not allow tow trucks on the property until the film is over.

WE'RE COMING WITH A GROUP. CAN WE PARK TOGETHER?

If you're coming in a group, we recommend carpooling. We park vehicles according to height; smaller cars in front, and the tallest must park in the back of the theater. Patrons must park in their assigned sections. Also please know that you are not allowed to save spaces for other vehicles.

HOW DO YOU HEAR THE FILM?

We broadcast the sound on an FM radio station. You must have a working FM radio in order to hear the sound. Radio apps do not work because we do not stream our sound through the internet.

WHAT DO I DO IF MY PARKING ZONE IS FULL WHEN I ARRIVE?

If you arrive and your parking zone is filled, you may find the closest spot behind your original parking zone. For example: if you're a mid-sized SUV in the Green parking zone and it's full, you can bump back to the red parking zone, but you cannot move forward to the Yellow parking zone because those vehicles are much smaller than a mid-size SUV.
