- Volunteers must not handle hazardous waste. To correctly identify hazardous waste, flags have been provided in the supply kits. Volunteers are requested to place a flag within one foot of any questionable items.
- If any syringes, illegal drugs, drug paraphernalia, or weapons are found, the Group Lead should place a flag near the item and call Weld County Dispatch at 720-652-4222 to report it to the Firestone Police Department.
