## 2022 MUNICIPAL ELECTION INFORMATION

**ELECTION DAY:  
TUESDAY, APRIL 5, 2022**

### Important dates & information for voters:

» *2022 Mail Ballot Election 101 Presentation* **Monday, March 14 at 6:30 p.m.** in the Board Room/Court Room in the Firestone Police Department (9900 Park Avenue).

- » Week of **March 14-18**, ballots are expected to be mailed. All registered voters should expect to see their ballot in the mail within that next week.
- » After you receive and complete your ballot, put your ballot back in the provided envelope. Once you have sealed your envelope you may mail it or drop it off.
  - **MAIL IT:** Include proper postage of a first-class or forever stamp on the provided envelope and mail it. If you have not mailed your ballot by Tuesday, March 29, we encourage you to drop it off or bring it to the Voter Service Center.
  - **DROP IT OFF:** Save a stamp and drop it off at the 24-hour drop-box located at the front of Town Hall at 9950 Park Avenue.
- » Come to the **Voter Service Center** if you need to register to vote, a replacement ballot or voter assistance.
  - **LOCATION:** 9900 Park Avenue (Court Room/Board Room)
  - **DATES:** April 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and April 5<sup>th</sup> from 7:00 a.m. - 7:00 p.m.

### DO I QUALIFY?

- Must live within the Town of Firestone; and
- Be 60+ years old; or
- Be under 18 years old\*; or
- Be disabled or have a temporary disability ; or
- Live in a household that has a household income of below 80% Area Median Income

\*Youth riders under 14 years old must be accompanied by a qualified rider; Youth riders 14-17 years old must be placed on van by an adult/employer.

### WHERE CAN I GO?

- Via can take you almost anywhere you would like to go, including medical appointments, therapy, grocery stores, social events, senior centers, adult day programs, employment, and more.
- Via can also pick up and deliver pre-paid grocery orders within the Town of Firestone.
- Service is available within the Town of Firestone and between Firestone and Frederick, Dacono, Erie, Longmont, Louisville, or Lafayette. Service between communities may be limited to certain days.
