



## Temporary Hail Damage Roof Inspection Process

This process will be in effect From August 23<sup>rd</sup>  
through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023

Homeowners, The Town of Firestone is implementing temporary roof inspection processes valid only from August 23<sup>rd</sup> through December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2023. Please answer all three questions and return this document to the Building Division by 1) The contractor can upload to the portal for this permit. 2) The homeowner can return this document to [building@firestoneco.gov](mailto:building@firestoneco.gov). or 3) The homeowner can deliver this completed document to Town Hall, Building window

You will have the option of three different methods of roof inspections or completions of your roof permit. If you choose to forego your Mid-Roof inspection (question 3), the homeowner must sign and have their signature notarized.

1) I am requesting the Town of Firestone Building Division perform my required Mid-Roof and Final Inspections. No signature is required.

2) I am requesting that my State of Colorado Licensed Engineer perform my required Mid-Roof and Final Roof inspections at my own cost and provide those results to the town per the special inspection requirements of the IBC 1704.2.4, 110.3. No signature is required.
